BULLET TRAIN PROJECT

Breakthrough in first mountain tunnel achieved in Valsad district

THE BREAKTHROUGH in the first mountain tunnel in the Mumbai-Ahmedabad High Speed Rail Corridor, popularly called the bullet train, was achieved Thursday in Valsad, the National High Speed Rail Corporation Limited (NHSRCL) said.

The 350-metre-long tunnel is 12.6 metres in diameter and 10.25 metres high. The single tube horse-shoe-shaped tunnel consists of two tracks.

According to NHSRCL spokesperson Sushma Gaur, there are seven mountain tunnels that fall on the Mumbai-Ahmedabad route out of which one is Zaroli village in Umbergaon taluka of Valsad district, while the remaining six are in Palghar district of Maharashtra.

The tunnel, which is located some one km away from Zaroli, was completed in 10 months using the New Austrian Tunneling Method (NATM), the NHSRCL release said.

The six mountain tunnels in Palghar district are at Kasabekaman (which is 820 m), Mithanagar (1.48 kms), Vasantwadi (454 m), Ambesari (387 m), and two mountain tunnels in Chadrasar village that are 2.663 kms. There is a 21-km-long tunnel, including 7 kms under-sea, in Thane district of Maharashtra.

All the seven mountain tunnels will be constructed using the NATM that involves marking drill holes on the tunnel face, drilling holes, charging explosives, controlled blasting, muck removal, and the installation of primary support, NHSRCL said.

The high-speed train corridor will also have a 21 kilometre tunnel between Bandra-Kurla Complex in Mumbai and Shilphata in Thane district, and 7 kilometres of this tunnel will be under Thane creek, making it the first undersea tunnel in the country. This will also be the longest tunnel of the project.

The eight railway stations of the bullet train project in Gujarat — at Vapi, Bilimora, Surat, Bharuch, Vadodara, Anand, Ahmedabad and Sabarmati — are at various stages of construction.

Out of the 24 river bridges falling along the bullet train project, 20 are in Gujarat, while the remaining four are in Maharashtra. Work on five bridges in Gujarat — on Par river (Valsad), Purna river (Navsari), Mindhola river (Navsari), Ambika river (Navsari) and Auranga river (Valsad) — has been completed.

MURDER-CUM-LOOT CASE IN MAHISAGAR

Singed hair lands 'friend' who killed bank manager in police net

SINGED HAIR and beard of the prime suspect helped the police crack the murder case of a private bank manager from Balasinor who was found dead and his vehicle set on fire on the Santrampur-Dahod highway in Mahisagar on Tuesday night.

The Santrampur police arrested Harshil Patel (25), and recovered the cash hours after recovering the body of Vishal Patil who was travelling from Balasinor to Dahod to hand over Rs 1.18 crore in cash to another branch of the bank Tuesday.

According to police, the accused, who was accompanying the bank manager in his vehicle, "instantly" decided to murder his "friend" after finding out about the money in the car.

"Since the receiving branch was making several phone calls to Patil about his location, Patel had understood that he was carrying a huge quantity of cash in the vehicle. He appears to have immediately decided to murder him and waited until it was dark... Around 7.30pm, when they stopped for a break at a deserted road, Patel turned up behind Patil and shot him in the head, killing him instantly," Mahisagar Superintendent of Police Jaydeepsinh Jadeja told *The Indian Express*.

Jadeja added that the accused dumped the body and the weapon — an unlicensed firearm acquired from Madhya Pradesh — at the spot and drove away with Patil's SUV and the cash to a spot about 17 kilometres away where he had parked his two-wheeler earlier in the day. "He

then emptied the cash from the metal box in Patil's car into a bag and rode to his village in Dahod on his two-wheeler. From there, he returned with his four-wheeler (SUV) to the spot where he had left Patil's vehicle... He doused it with petrol and set it on fire, he has admitted. As the fire bellowed, his hair was singed and it was a big give away when we picked him up and he admitted to his crime," Jadeja added.

Patel told the police that he had known Patil since a few years when the latter was posted as a branch manager in the Dahod village where the parents of the accused are teachers at a local school.

"The son of the deceased was also tracking the location of the vehicle on a mobile application of the car maker Tuesday as the receiving bank was anxious that Patil had not turned up with the

cash and was unreachable. Patil's son had also called up the accused to seek his help in finding out why the vehicle was stationary at the spot on the Santrampur-Dahod road... The accused was actually setting fire to the vehicle then. He tried to misguide the police,"

Jadeja added. Police said that Patel, who has been booked for loot with murder as well as destruction of evidence, does not have a history of crime but had acquired the firearm out of "fancy" as he has claimed.
